Little Women

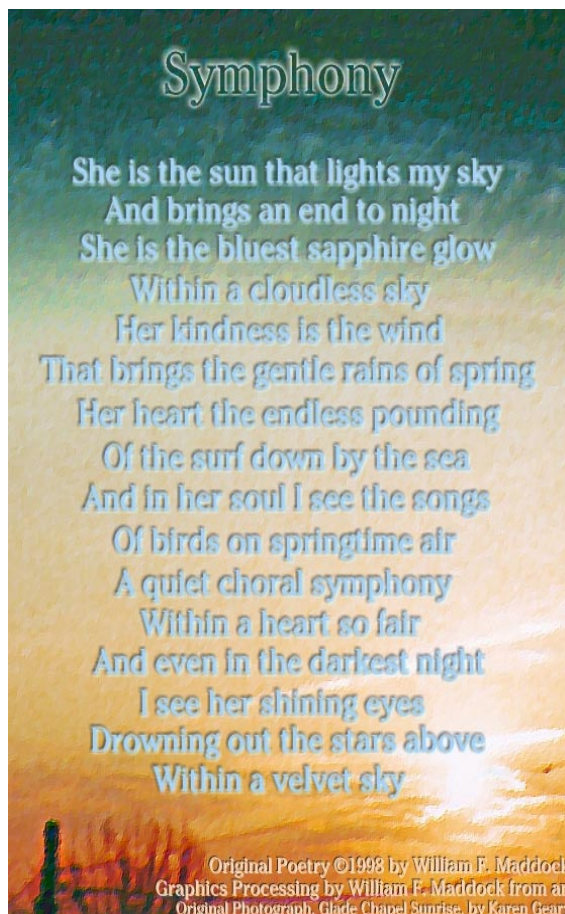
Drifting
